DISABLE WINDOWS STARTUP SOUND

You know you pressed the power button on your computer, you know Windows is starting up, but does that mean you have to be annoyed by the musical chord that chimes to indicate that your machine has booted?

If you would prefer having Windows 10 startup silently, follow these steps:

- 1. In the Search Box type **mmsys.cpl** and press Enter.
- 2. The sound dialog window will open up. Click the **Sounds** tab.
- 3. At the bottom you'll see a checkbox that says "**Play Windows Startup Sound**". Un-check it, and press **OK**.
- 4. The next time you start your computer, it will no longer sound a musical chord.
- 5. If you want the sound back, just follow these steps and re-check the box!
