

MAKE SURE WINDOWS UPDATE IS TURNED ON

If you sense that Windows Update is turned off, here are the steps you can take to enable it:

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Click **Update & Security**. Your Windows update and Windows security settings are loaded.
3. Click **Windows Update** to access this tool and its settings.
4. Click **Advanced options**.
5. In the Choose How Updates Are Installed drop-down list, select **Automatic Install Windows Updates**

Once Windows Update is turned on, Windows 10 automatically checks for updates and installs them. However, you can manually check for updates and install them anytime you want. Here's how:

1. Open **Settings**.
2. Click **Update & Security**, then click **Windows Update**. Windows Update is now shown on the screen.
3. Click **Check for Updates**. If updates are available, they're automatically downloaded and installed. For some updates, a restart may be required, and if so, Windows 10 automatically schedules it for you.
4. Decide whether to restart now or later: • To restart now, close all open files and programs and click Restart Now. • To restart your computer at a different time, specify the time in the scheduling fields.
