

Turn On Autocomplete in Internet Explorer/Edge

From within your Internet Explorer browser, AutoComplete makes suggestions in a pull-down menu as you type information into your locator bar. You can choose to have Internet Explorer search browsing history, favorites or feeds, and choose whether or not to have suggestions from Windows Live Search.

If this feature has been disabled in your IE, you will certainly want to turn it back on. Follow these steps to do so:

1. Click Tools in the upper right corner of your browser (it's a cog wheel) or Tools from the Menu bar.
2. Click on Internet Options.
3. Click on the Content tab.
4. From within the AutoComplete area, click Settings.
5. Select Address bar and any of the four subsets.
6. Click OK.

From within the Edge browser, click on the three horizontal dots that appear in the upper right corner of the menu bar.

1. Click on Settings.
2. Click on View advanced settings.
3. Turn on Show search and settings suggestions as I type
