


WHAT EDITION AND VERSION OF WINDOWS 10 DO YOU HAVE? HERE'S HOW TO FIND OUT!

1. From your Desktop, go to Windows Settings (shortcut: Windows key + I)
2. Click on System.
3. Click on About (it will appear at the bottom of the left column)
4. The right column will list your Windows 10 edition and version, plus other information that you will find useful.
